Capital Region Partnership for Career Development



Brief History of the Partnership

Became a School to Work Partnership in 1995, through the Federal legislation, School to Work Opportunities Act of 1994.

We were one of 55 such Partnerships in Pennsylvania developed during the five years of Federal seed money availability. After seed money disappeared many of the original partnerships disappeared and now we are one of 12 such partnerships in Pennsylvania.

Officially named the Partnership for Career Education in 1999. The name was changed to the Capital Region Partnership for Career Development in 2005 and a new logo followed.

The first full-time coordinator was hired in February 2006. The Partnership was governed then a a cross-community Steering Committee.

A full-time Program Specialist was added in September 2007.

In 2008 the logo was changed to match the logo of the CAIU. (Capital Area Intermediate Unit)

Moved to the HACC Penn Center Building in 2008 and to the Capital Area Intermediate Unit in Enola in 2009.

Officially became a 501-(c)3 charitable organization in 2010.

The Partnership actually began as a Resource Center to connect teachers to materials and business contacts and to help students in the process.

Things grew and grew and grew... and you will hear more of the story.

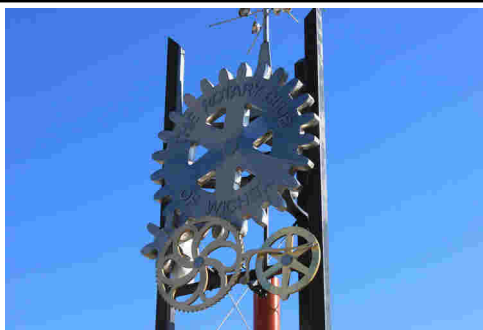

Wichita's New
 Rotary Time Tower



On January 9, 2012, the Rotary Club of Wichita, Sedgwick County, Coleman, and Wichita Downtown Development Corporation participated in the unveiling of the new Rotary Time Tower in downtown Wichita. The Rotary Time Tower was a gift from the Rotary Club of Wichita in honor of its centennial year. The tower, which was designed by local artist Todd Whipple of Whipple Studios LLC and created by Law Kingdon, stands four stories tall on the corner of St. Francis and 2nd Street. The sculpture marks time by producing sound every 15 minutes, moves with the wind and lights up at night.
